### EXPLANATION OF MEMBERSHIP CLASSES

**Regular Member:** Any pharmacist who is licensed to practice pharmacy in the province of Newfoundland & Labrador.

**Associate Member:** Any person who is employed directly or indirectly in the profession of pharmacy and who has an interest in the conduct of the profession in Newfoundland & Labrador and who is not otherwise eligible for membership as a Regular Member.

**Supporting Member:** Any person who was licensed to practice pharmacy in the Province of Newfoundland & Labrador, but is now non-practicing.

**Student Member:** Any person who is enrolled as a student in a school, faculty or college of pharmacy whereby completion of its academic qualifications would confer a prerequisite for the practice of pharmacy in Newfoundland & Labrador.

### EXPLANATION OF ZONE DESIGNATIONS *(for Regular Members Only)*

**Zone 1- Eastern Zone:** Shall be comprised of all of the Avalon Peninsula and all of the Burin Peninsula up to and including Goobies and east. Regular Members whose principal place of practice is located in the Eastern Zone shall register in the Eastern Zone.

**Zone 2- Central Zone:** Shall be comprised of the area west of Goobies including the Bonavista Peninsula, Grand Falls-Windsor, Buchans and that part of the South Coast that does not include Burgeo and Ramea. Regular Members whose principal place of practice is located in the Central Zone shall register in the Central Zone.

**Zone 3 - Western Zone:** Shall be comprised of the area west of Grand Falls-Windsor, including the Baie Verte Peninsula, White Bay, the Northern Peninsula, Labrador, the west coast extending to Port-aux-Basques and that part of the south coast that includes Burgeo and Ramea. Regular Members whose principal place of practice is located in the Western Zone shall register in the Western Zone.

**Zone 4- Hospital Zone:** Shall be comprised of Regular Members who are registered as per their primary occupation in a hospital or related institution in the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador.

*NOTE: Regular Members who are not Hospital Pharmacists and who do not have a principal place of practice shall register in the Zone in which their principal place of residence is located.
