Future Leader Award in Pharmacy recognizes significant contributions** to the undergraduate student body, an academic proficiency and the likelihood of noteworthy future contributions to the profession through pharmacy associations. This year's recipient from Memorial University of Jeremy Reid.

- **The Ralph J. Harris Future of Pharmacy Award** was presented to Sarah Strong, a 3<sup>rd</sup> year pharmacy student Memorial University's School of Pharmacy. This scholarship and travel bursary is presented to a student who exudes enthusiasm and passion for the future of pharmacy, is a visionary, involved in community volunteer work and offers extraordinary promise to the profession.
- **PANL Student Spirit Award** was presented to Jonathan Edwards, a 3<sup>rd</sup> year pharmacy student enrolled in the School of Pharmacy at Memorial University. This scholarship and travel bursary is presented to a student who has made contributions to the Association through activities with PANL as a volunteer, committee member or supporter.
- **The J. Frank Janes Meritorious Service Award** was awarded to St. John's pharmacist Deborah Kelly. This award is given to a member of the Association, an organization or group, or any person, in recognition of service that brings credit and prestige to the profession.
- **The James C. Quick Award** was awarded to St. John's pharmacist Barbara Thomas. This award is presented to a pharmacist who has introduced innovative methods or services into pharmacy care; or who has, by his initiative, broadened the scope of the practice of pharmacy in the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador.
- **The Wyeth Apothecary Award** was awarded to St. John's pharmacist Dr. Stephanie Young. This award recognizes Pharmacists who have completed specialty education or training and who, as a result, have successfully expanded their professional practice.
- **The Past-President Award** program has for many years recognized the dedication, commitment and achievements accomplished by the President of each of the provincial pharmacy associations. This year the Association recognized St. John's pharmacist Trent White out-going President of the Pharmacists' Association of Newfoundland and Labrador.
- The most prestigious pharmacy award in North America is the **Wyeth Consumer Healthcare Bowl of Hygeia Award**. This award recognizes outstanding community service through pharmacy, and has been awarded this year to pharmacist Randell Collins.
