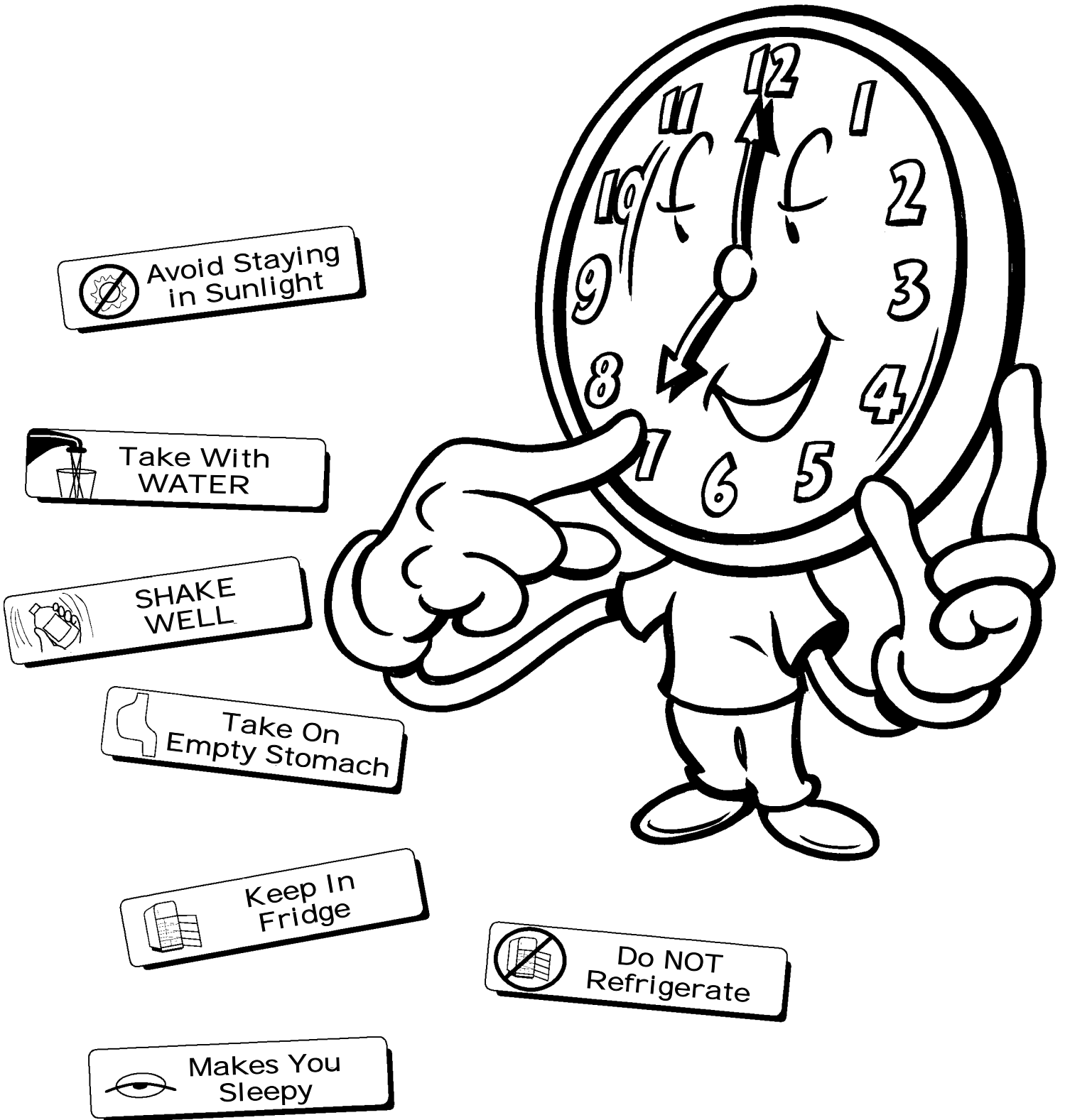


Pharmacists work in hospitals

cure sick people

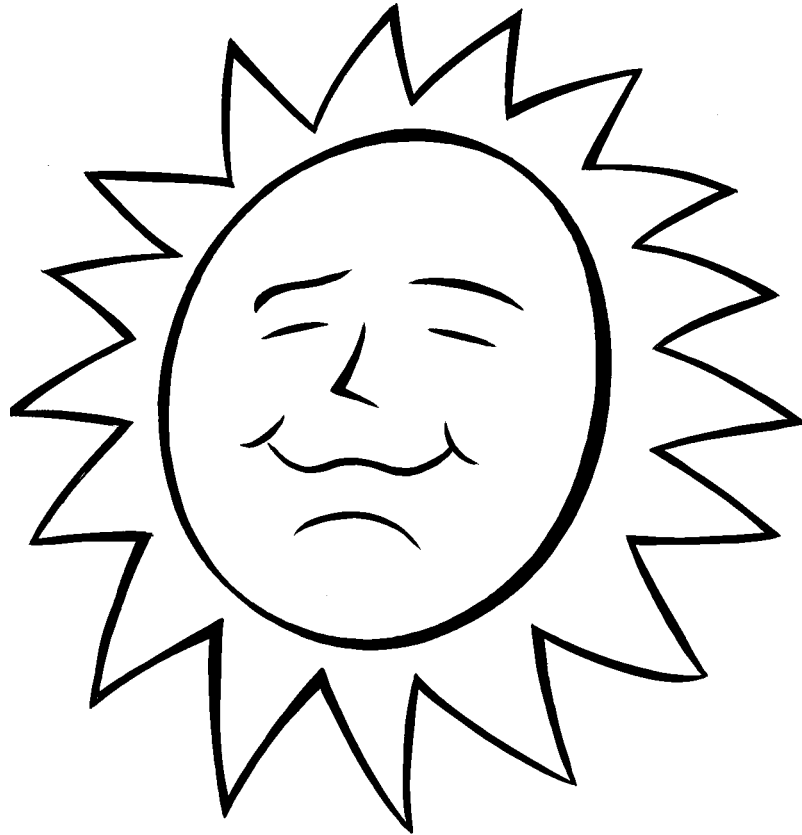
Pharmacists tell you how and when to take your medicine
