TWO TENURE TRACK APPOINTMENTS

Applications are invited for a **two** full time tenure track appointments in Pharmacy Practice. The appointments will be at the level of Assistant Professor. Applicants must hold a Pharm. D. or equivalent degree. Teaching in the undergraduate/graduate programs, supervision of undergraduate students during structured practice experiences, supervision of graduate students, engaging in research/scholarly activities and rendering academic service will be expected. The establishment of a clinical practice will also be required.

A joint appointment with the Eastern Regional Health Authority will be considered for candidates with suitable qualifications and experience.

A completed earned doctorate is required for the appointee to receive the rank of Assistant Professor and to be in a tenure-track position. (If a successful candidate has not completed an earned doctorate, he/she shall be appointed to a regular term, non-renewable three-year appointment at the rank of Assistant Professor. If the candidate completes all the requirements for the doctorate during the first 24 months of the term appointment, he/she shall begin a tenure-track appointment following completion of the requirements of the degree).

The School of Pharmacy is accredited by the Canadian Council for Accreditation of Pharmacy Programs. Research strengths include drug delivery, drug targeting and drug discovery and development and inter-professional education. Collaborative research with Canadian, American and globally-recognized universities and research institutes is encouraged.
